Definitions

Best Shark – the best shark will always be the one whose points score is the greatest when expressed as a percentage of the points score of the British Record or the British Measured & Released Record, whichever is the greatest, for the species

British Waters - Means a boat operating from a British Port situated on any part of the coast of Great Britain, Northern Ireland and all those offshore islands from Shetland in the North and the Scillies and the Channel Islands in the south. The boat from which the shark is caught and released shall have been fishing at the time of the catch within the limits of the vessel, the skippers coding and licence and must both leave and return to a British Port.

One Day – a normal 8 to 9 hour trip form leaving port to returning to port

Season – The season starts on the 1st October and extends to the 30th September

Single Handed – means that the angler must completely unaided catch and bring the shark aboard the boat. The skipper and any other person on board must assume the role of onlooker, giving no assistance

Points Score – the points score of a shark is the length, nose to fork of tail, and the girth taken to the front of, but including the dorsal fin, added together. Both dimensions are measured in inches.

Shark Welfare

The club will consider the attention paid to the welfare and handling of all sharks which are the subject of trophy claims. Any claim which has not delivered the highest standard of welfare and handling to the shark will potentially disqualify the claim. The SACGB committee decision will be final in these matters

- 14. **Leslie Andrews Light Tackle** For the best shark caught during the season on a line of 24kgs (50lbs) breaking strain or less. The angler with the highest ratio of shark weight to tested breaking strain of line will be the winner. 450cms (5yards) of the line used must accompany the claim
- 15. **European Trophy** For the best shark of 105 points or over caught in British Waters during the season by a member resident in the continent of Europe (excluding Great Britain)
- 16. T. N. Foster For the heaviest shark caught during the season outside the coastal waters of Britain by a member living in or outside Britain. For this trophy the committee will accept claims for sharks which have been measured or visually estimated by the skipper but in all cases the claim must include photographic or video evidence.
- 17. **R. C. Roberts** For the non-member who catches the best qualifying shark of the season. The angler must use this shark to join the SACGB to qualify for the trophy

- 18. Marsden Sutcliffe Trophy For the best shark of the season by a junior member
- Daphne Case For the best Blue shark caught in Looe waters by a member with a PL13 postcode
- 20. **W. K. Wileman Midland Trophy** For the best shark of the season by a member resident within 50 miles of Nuneaton
- 21. The Carl Aldridge Trophy For the runner up to the W.K. Wileman Midland Trophy
- 22. Ron Gibson For the best shark of the season by a member resident in Yorkshire
- 23. Derek Denne For the best shark of the season by a member resident in Devon
- 24. **K. Bones Essex Trophy** For the best shark of the season caught by a member resident in Essex
- 25. **F. Crow London Trophy** For the best shark of the season caught by a member whose permanent postal address includes "London"
- 26. **Hampshire Trophy** For the best shark of the season caught by a member resident in Hampshire

- 29. **The Cornish Trophy** For the best shark of the season caught by a member resident in Cornwall
- 30. **Redknap Trophy** For the best shark of the season caught by a member resident in Oxford
- 31. **Brooks Elliot Trophy** For the best shark of the season caught by a member resident in Buckinghamshire
- 32. **Gloucestershire Trophy** For the best shark of the season caught by a member resident in Gloucestershire
- 33. **Pearl Trophy** For the best shark of the season caught by a member resident in Lancashire

- 34. **J. J. Holmes** For the best shark caught during the season by a member resident in Sussex
- 35. **Glaisbasel Trophy** For the best shark on the lightest line caught in British Waters. The maximum breaking strain line to be used is 20lbs
- 36. **R. J. Day Trophy** For the best shark of the season caught by a member resident in Hertfordshire
- 37. **C. C. Bett Trophy** For the biggest shark caught anywhere in the world by a resident of Somerset. For this trophy the committee will accept claims for sharks which have been measured or visually estimated by the skipper but in all cases the claim must include photographic or video evidence.
- 38. **Iris Memorial Trophy** For the best shark, caught, measured and released from Looe between 22nd July and 8th October by a member. Boat to leave and return to Looe on the same day.
- 39. **Jolly Sailor Trophy** for the angler who achieves the most combined points of sharks during the annual SACGB Festival
- 40. **The Sharky Martin Shield** For the best shark of the season, caught and released in British Waters by a member of age 65 or over
- 41. **Monthly Cups** a cup will be awarded to the member catching the best shark for each month during the season

Skipper Challenge Trophies (Looe only)

- Cock of the Fleet For the skipper (member) of the boat catching the best shark of the season
- 2. **Fishermans Protection** For the skipper (member) of the boat catching the most sharks in any one day
- 3. **Fred & Betty Reid Memorial Cup** For the skipper (member) of the boat catching the first qualifying shark of the season

4. **Kingerlee Trophy** – For the skipper (non-member) of the boat catching the best shark of the season

Skipper Challenge Trophies

- 1. **T. Clark** For the skipper (member) of the boat catching the best shark of the season
- 2. **Dusty Miller** For the skipper (member) who catches the most sharks of qualifying size during the season
- 3. **Chairmans Trophy** For the skipper (member) who catches the first shark of the calendar year
- 4. Ivan Chaston Memorial Trophy For the winning skipper at the Annual Looe Festival

Trophies for Visually Estimated Sharks

- 2. S.A.C.G.B. Mustad Trophy this trophy is not species specific
- 3. K. J. Tapper Trophy this trophy is not species specific

Unless otherwise stated the claim period for all trophies is "during the season" and only for sharks caught and released in British Waters.

The R C Roberts trophy is open to non-members and will be awarded to the winning applicant provided they join the club at the time the application is made.

The minimum total points of a shark which may be entered for any of the Clubs trophies is 96 points unless in certain cases a challenge trophy may be awarded by weight or species. This will be at the discretion of the committee.

All sharks must have been released in good condition back into the water.

The "Best Shark" will always be the one whose points score is the greatest when expressed as a percentage of the points score of the British Record, or the British Measured and Released Record, whichever is the greater, for the species.

All trophy claims must be made on the Clubs Trophy Declaration Form.

The number of points is determined by combining the length of the shark, from the tip of the nose to the fork of the tail, and the girth measurement, taken to the front of the dorsal fin but excluding the dorsal fin. The measurements are to be taken in inches.

All trophy claims must be verified and signed by a witness. Photographic and/or video evidence is preferred in all cases and in some cases it is mandatory. The committee shall, from time to time, require additional evidence. The committee decision with all claims will be final.
