Matters Arising

- 1. Trophy Repairs update. S Dabney has taken the Pearl trophy for a quote which is roughly £150. The search is ongoing for repairs to the Fred and Betty and Fisherman's Protection Trophies.
- 2. Tapes for Festival 2 tapes received and are good. The remaining 8 have now been ordered.
- 3. Pat Smith Database email from John McMaster stating that due to unresolvable differences of opinion, the match funding previously agreed was no longer needed. K Tapper asked if the Committee would agree to send the following letter of support to the Pat Smith Database:

The Shark Angling Club of Great

Britain are one of the main contributors of both historical and ongoing shark catch data to the Pat Smith Database. Although our coast are visited regularly by Blue, Porbeagle and Thresher sharks we know very little about them, to the point they are classed by the scientific community as data deficient. Sharks are threatened all over the world and with them being apex predators the marine ecosystem is highly dependant on them being present.

In order to provide them with further protection we need more information, hence the reason for our support of the Shark Mucous Swabbing project being proposed by the Pat Smith Database.

A discussion took place. It was agreed that time was needed to consider this and that it would be discussed again, next month.

4. Webcam – update. The Portbyhan webcam was now working properly and the secretary had advised the Social Club that this was not now needed.
